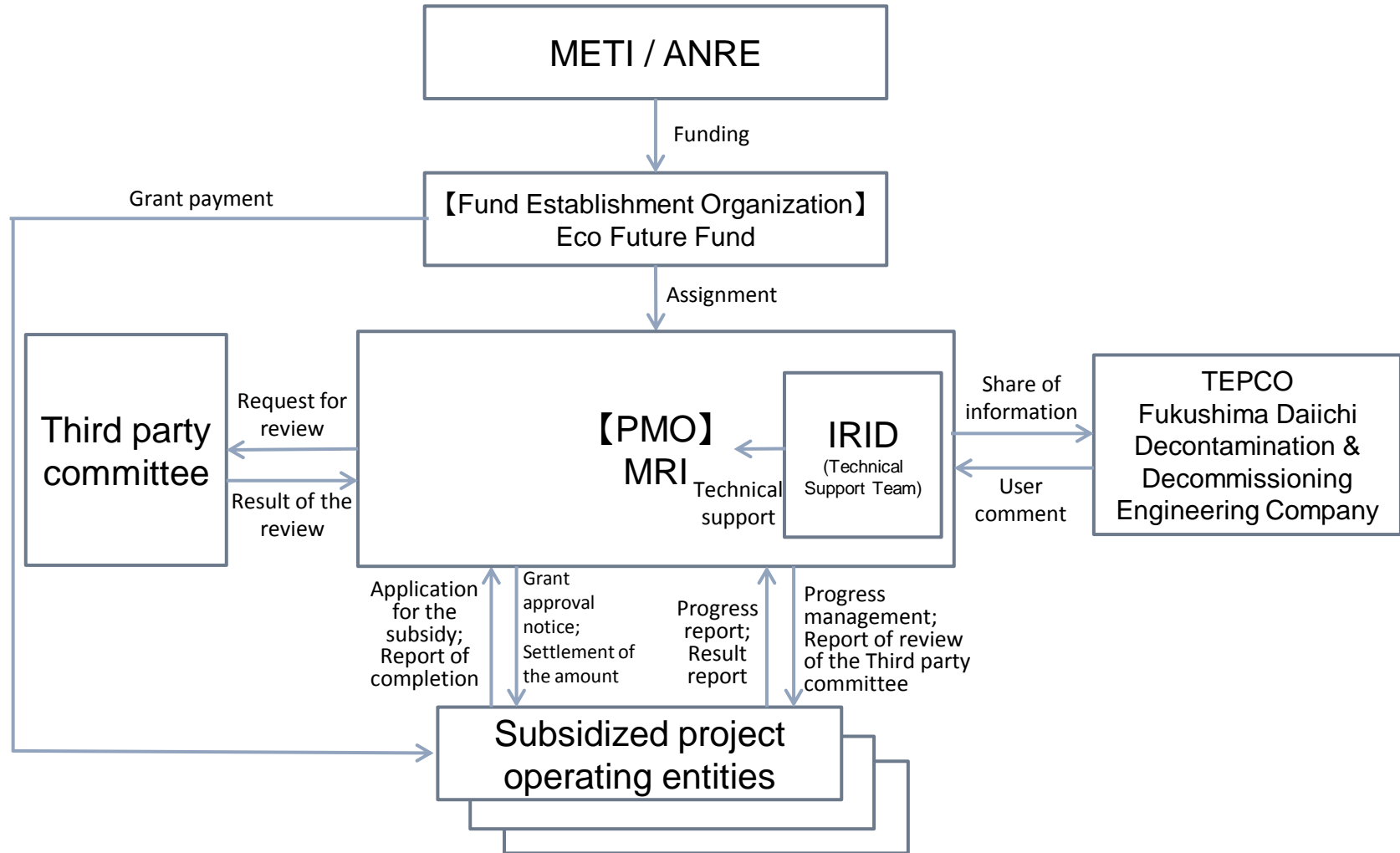

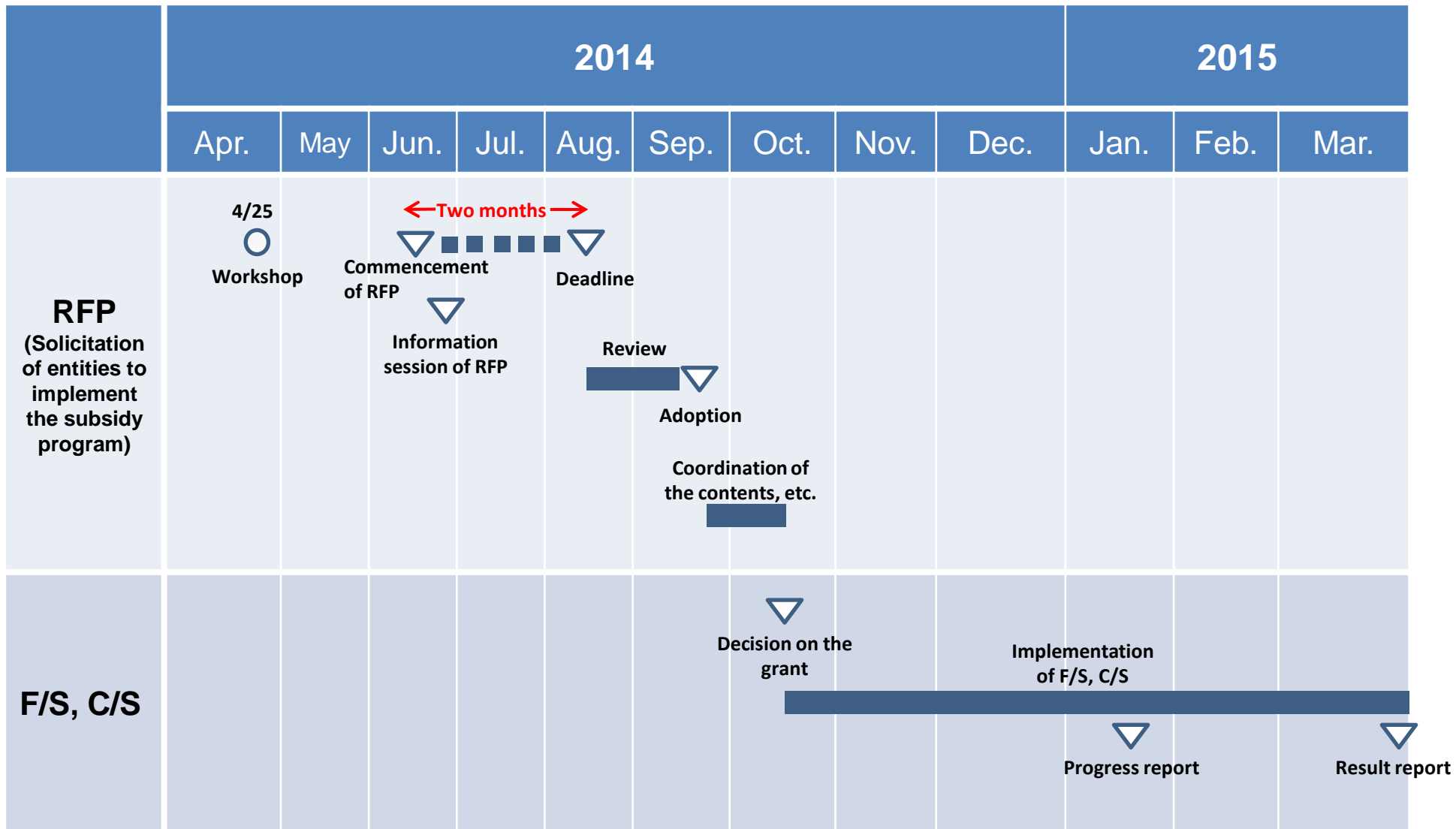
Project Scheme



Role and Purpose of RFI and RFP

- Difference between the RFI (Solicitation of technical information) conducted from December 2013 to January 2014, and the RFP (Solicitation of entities to implement the subsidy program) being explained today
 - RFI (Solicitation of proposals on technology) is a process of requesting information, the purpose of which is to grasp what technologies or ideas exist, in order to gather domestic and overseas wisdom
 - Forthcoming RFP is a solicitation process to decide implementing entities conducting C/S (conceptual study) and F/S (feasibility study) with subsidies from ANRE
- Treatment of the information received in the RFI process
 - The information received in the RFI process has been utilized to establish technical specifications for the RFP
 - In accordance with the procedures of the RFI, the information classified as NDI (Non-Disclosure Information) was shared solely with the team specifically set up in IRID, with ANRE, and with TEPCO
- Regarding the RFP (Solicitation of entities to implement the subsidy program)
 - Those who did not participate in the RFI are also eligible for the RFP process
 - Those who plan to participate in the RFP (Solicitation of entities to implement the subsidy program) must submit application documents in compliance with the stipulated forms after commencement of the process
